The temporal muscle, also known as the temporalis, is a flat, fan-shaped muscle of mastication on the lateral side of the head. It is a broad muscle on each side of the skull. The muscle lies within the temporal fossa, superior to the zygomatic arch so it covers much of the temporal bone.
