Playing the violin entails holding the instrument under the chin, supported by the left shoulder (see below for variations of this posture). The strings are sounded either by drawing the bow across them ( ), or by plucking them ( ). The left hand regulates the sounding length of the strings by stopping them against the fingerboard with the fingers, producing different notes.

The violin, sometimes known as a fiddle, is a wooden string instrument in the violin family. Most violins have a hollow wooden body. It is the smallest and highest-pitched instrument in the family in regular use. Smaller violin-type instruments exist, including the violino piccolo and the kit violin, but these are virtually unused. The violin typically has four strings, usually tuned in perfect ...

When you look at a string instrument, the first thing you'll probably notice is that it's made of wood, so why is it called a string instrument? The bodies of the string instruments, which are hollow inside to allow sound to vibrate within them, are made of different kinds of wood, but the part of the instrument that makes the sound is the strings, which are made of nylon, steel or sometimes gut.

### String Family Instruments - What is in the String Family?

Try a tuning fork or piano if you can find the notes. The notes you need to find and play are G, D, A, and E, which match the violin strings. On the piano, the "G" is the one just below middle "C," and every other note you need is spaced out at 5 intervals higher, starting with "D." Play the note on the piano or tuning fork, then play the matching string on your violin.
