Transitive Verbs of Motion. Transitive verbs of motion indicate the means by which the direct object, rather than the subject, moves. Russian maintains three basic (unprefixed) transitive verbs of motion meaning "carry" and differing in whether the "carrier" is on foot or traveling by some means of locomotion and whether the "carryee" is on foot.

1. Unidirectional and Multidirectional Verbs of Motion: идти vs ходить: In addition to going by foot vs vehicle distinction, Russian distinguishes between going in one direction or setting out (я иду; я еду) and making trips back and forth (я хожу; я езжу)..
