Above: *Fucus vesiculosus* is a common brown seaweed of rocky shores. The holdfast or hapteron firmly fastens the organism to almost any solid surface. The thick midrib of the leaf-like lamina connects to the stalk or stipe which connects directly to the holdfast. The body of the seaweed, or thallus, is strap-like and forks at regular intervals, a growth form called dichotomous branching ...
